What does my Boa eat?

These are carnivorous snakes and eat their prey whole. Smaller snakes eat mice, while larger, mature boas eat rats, rabbits, or even pigs.

How often does my Boa eat?

A feeding schedule of every 5 to 7 days is suitable for babies, while adults can be fed once every 7 to 10 days.

Tank size?

A good enclosure size for an adult boa constrictor is around 6 to 8 feet long, 2 to 3 feet wide, and 2 to 3 feet tall. The minimum size is around 10 square feet of floor space for a single snake. Hide boxes are essential to make your snake feel secure

Does Boas need heat?

Boas should always be offered heat, and their ambients should never fall below 80F as this can lead to RIs. ... In my opinion, the best way is by using a heating element that raises ambient temperatures, such a radiant heat panel (RHP), ceramic heat emitter (CHE), or the classic heat lamp.

Are Boas Friendly?

Boa Constrictors are often tame when they are handled frequently, but they are also very strong and may coil themselves tightly around you if they feel threatened.
